




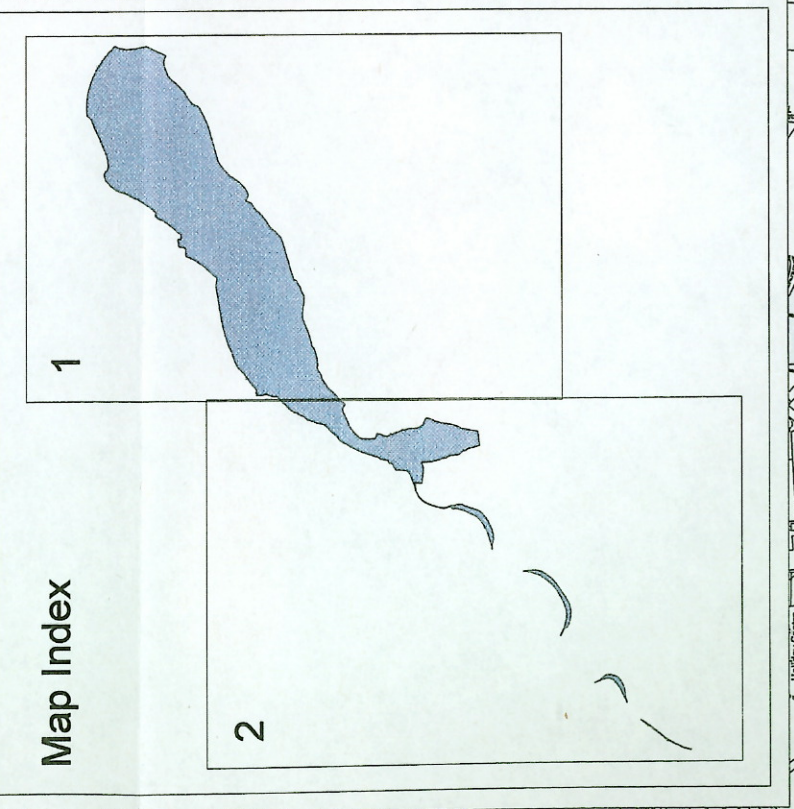

A European marine site is defined in the conservation (Natural Habitats, & c) Regulations 1994 as a Special Area of Conservation (SAC) or Special Protection Area (SPA) or part of one which is covered continuously or intermittently by tidal waters.  
The landward boundary is the Highest Astronomical Tide. The seaward boundary is that of the constituent SAC or SPA. Where the boundary follows Mean Low Water it is liable to change.  
Coastal waters throughout the site are used by feeding birds.
