Site description:

This is a complex of two marsh fritillary butterfly *Euphydryas aurinia* populations which may form a single metapopulation. They inhabit a damp purple moor-grass *Molinia caerulea* or tufted hair-grass *Deschampsia cespitosa* dominated grassland/scrub mosaic. These and the Braithwaite Moss population (within the River Derwent and Bassenthwaite Lake SAC) comprise a north-western set of populations which are genetically different to the other English populations.

Qualifying species: The site is designated under **article 4(4)** of the Directive (92/43/EEC) as it hosts the following species listed in Annex II:

• Marsh fritillary butterfly Euphydryas (Eurodryas, Hypodryas) aurinia
