Introduction

The People and Nature Survey for England: Children's survey (Experimental Statistics)

The People and Nature Survey for England gathers vital information about people's enjoyment, access and attitudes to the natural environment, its contributions to our health and wellbeing and the actions people take to protect it. Some data about children's engagement with nature is captured through the People & Nature core adult survey including questions about the pandemic. However, this does not ask children directly about their experiences. Natural England commissioned Kantar to develop and conduct a survey of 1,500 children aged 8 to 15 in England about their experiences during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The survey was conducted using the Kantar Lightspeed panel. This brings benefits in terms of speed, ability to interview during lockdown and reducing social desirability bias. The survey was conducted on-line continuously between 6th-18th August 2020 (inclusive).

National Statistic Status

Reporting from this survey will be done as Experimental Statistics. This status highlights to users that the statistics are in the testing phase and that Natural England is still working on further developing the methodologies used in their production. More detail on this can be found in the People and Nature Survey for England <u>Technical report</u> (September 2020). Natural England have worked to ensure adherence to the Code of Practice for Statistics which assures compliance with the following pillars:

- Trustworthiness: is about having confidence in the people and organisations that produce statistics and data.
- Quality: is about using data and methods that produce assured statistics.
- Value: is about producing statistics that support society's needs for information.

Informed Consent

In order to gain explicit consent from both a parent/carer and the child themselves, the survey invites were sent to adult panellists. They answered screening questions to confirm that there was an eligible child in the household and that they agreed the child can take part. The child was also then required to agree to participate.

Survey Design

The survey took into consideration the age range of intended participants (8-15) and questions were designed with simplified language and response lists which included a mixture of icons, text and sliding scales to make it as easy as possible for children to understand and complete the survey.

In order to be representative of children aged 8 to 15 in England the survey had quotas on age, region and ethnicity. Age and region were taken from the ONS Mid-Year Population Estimates 2019. Ethnicity was taken from the Labour Force Survey (April-June 2019).
