Site description:

Brown Moss is an area of former heathland, now largely colonised by woodland, with a series of shallow pools. The site holds marsh, swamp and fen communities associated with the pools which occupy hollows in the sand and gravel substrate. The pools fluctuate considerably and apparently independently, in level and also vary in their water chemistry. Marginal vegetation includes tall communities dominated by great reedmace *Typha latifolia*, soft rush *Juncus effusus*, bur-reed *Sparganium erectum*, bottle sedge *Carex rostrata* and bladder sedge *C. vesicaria*. There are also extensive areas of shorter grassland and marsh at the margins of some of the pools, with common spike-rush *Eleocharis palustris* and creeping bent *Agrostis stolonifera* among the dominant species.

Floating water-plantain *Luronium natans* has been known to occur at Brown Moss for several years, and this site possibly represents a relict natural lowland population of the species. The population of floating water-plantain at Brown Moss is relatively small, and appears to behave as a metapopulation, colonising the various pools according to their suitability.

Qualifying species: The site is designated under **article 4(4)** of the Directive (92/43/EEC) as it hosts the following species listed in Annex II:

• Floating water-plantain Luronium natans
