- -Advises on biodiversity issues

- -Chaired by Defra
- -Comprises Defra, Natural England (NE), Environment Agency (EA) and Forestry Commission (FC) and 1 Wildlife NGO + 1 Landowner representative)
- -Oversees overall delivery of the Strategy including policy

People Engagement Group

- -Independent chair
- -Focus on putting 'people at the heart of strategy'
- -Community engagement/Big Society
- -Focus on outcome 4 delivery



Terrestrial Biodiversity Group

- -Chaired by Natural England
- -Focussed on delivery of terrestrial outcomes 1 & 3 (Ecosystems, habitats, protected sites and species)
- -Comprised of stakeholders with major delivery roles –NE, EA, FC, wildlife NGOs, landowner and farming reps etc
